

The Jasper County Commission met in general session on Tuesday, April 26, 2016, at 9:00 A.M. at the Jasper County Courthouse, room 101. The meeting was opened with the Pledge of Allegiance and prayer by Keith Stammer.

Roll Call:

John Bartosh, Darieus Adams and Jim Honey are present.

Approval of Minutes:

Commissioner Honey made the motion to approve the minutes from Tuesday, April 19, 2016.

Commissioner Adams seconded. Minutes approved.

Reports and Communications:

Commissioner Honey reports that the bridges the county is responsible for have been inspected by an Engineer from MoDot. There are 242 bridges over 20 foot and all are in very good shape. Commissioner Honey had Bob Burris and Rowdy Baugh, from the County Highway Department report on the MoDot findings. There are a few bridges in rural areas of the county that are a little outdated and have load limits, however, all bridges received a score of 6 or better, a score of three would indicate need for replacement. All bridges are thoroughly inspected and hip waders are used when necessary to inspect those bridges where part of the structure is submerged. Due to the depth of water, one bridge will be due for a dive inspection during next year's inspection.
